Common name: Common Madder, English: Common Madder, Marathi: manjishta, Sanskrit: manjishtha

Part used: Stem - The evergreen leaves are 5–10 cm long and 2–3 cm broad, produced in whorls of 4-7 star like around the central stem. It climbs with tiny hooks at the leaves and stems. Stems often have a long, rough, grooved, woody base
